**Please help us keep our children well! If your child is sick, refer to the Parent Handbook for guidelines as to when it's okay to return to school. In general, children should be fever and symptom free for 24 hours without the aid of medication before returning to school. If their tummy has been upset, please allow 48 hours before they return to school! Don't forget to call the office if your child is not attending CNC due to an illness.**
